

Classroom Management Philosophy Example



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For those who want the quick version, I have pulled the four most important points he made—four keys to setting up and implementing a classroom management plan so that it really works—and summarized them here.. Key 1: Have an Actual Plan. My biggest classroom management mistake was that “wait and see” mentality I mentioned before.

Creating A Plan 1. Know your philosophy. Classroom management plans begin with the teacher’s philosophy of motivation. Every teacher has one even if they all vary from one another and as they have their own morals and principles.

Making a good sample classroom management plan is important for teachers and students. For the teacher, the plan’s guidelines will inhibit her from resorting to counterproductive methods in dealing with misbehavior. The teacher’s application of the consequences of misbehavior will create an environment more conducive to the learning process.

"A teaching (philosophy) statement is a purposeful and reflective essay about the author’s teaching beliefs and practices. It is an individual narrative that includes not only one’s beliefs about the teaching and learning process but also concrete examples of the ways in which he or she enacts these beliefs in the classroom."

When you apply for a job as a teacher, you may be asked about your teaching philosophy. This is not the sort of question you should fumble or improvise on the fly - you’ll look unprepared for the job if you don’t have a ready answer.

How to Answer "What Is Your Teaching Philosophy?"

Once a teacher has developed a philosophy for classroom management, has created a plan for how the classroom should operate, has investigated the make-up of the class, and has secured information about school expectations, then the process of establishing classroom expectations can begin.

Developing Classroom Expectations - Project IDEAL

Brainstorm about your educational philosophy and your views of education, making notes on those principles you value most. This can help you articulate your philosophy as you organize your essay. Demonstrate how you have put your educational philosophy into practice in the classroom by citing specific examples and outcomes with students, parents, or fellow teachers and administrators.
