The Origins Of Genocide Raphael

Raphael Lemkin, Polish: Rafał Lemkin (June 24, 1900 – August 28, 1959) was a lawyer of Polish-Jewish descent who is best known for coining the word genocide and initiating the Genocide Convention. Lemkin coined the word genocide in 1943 or 1944 from *genos* (Latin for family, tribe, or race) and *-cide* (Latin for killing).

The United Nations Convention on the Prevention and Punishment of the Crime of Genocide. In 1946, the United Nations General Assembly adopted a resolution that “affirmed” that genocide was a crime under international law, but did not provide a legal definition of the crime.
